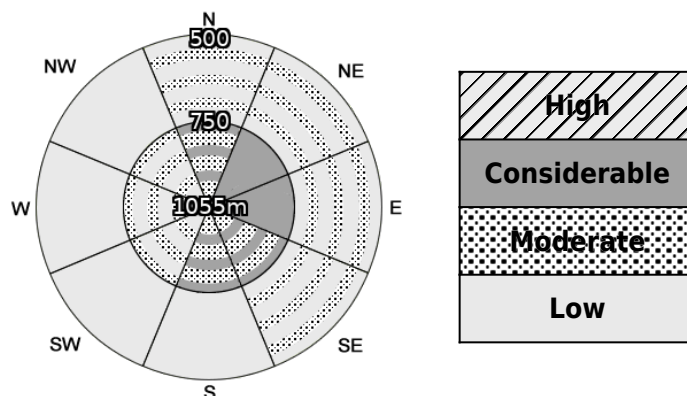
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to accumulate overnight, primarily on North through East to South-East aspects above 750 metres with other aspects being affected due to cross loading. Cornices will continue to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate North-West backing South-West winds and the odd snow shower overnight. Dry during the day. The wind will back further to the South-East increasing in strength by the end of the forecast period.
