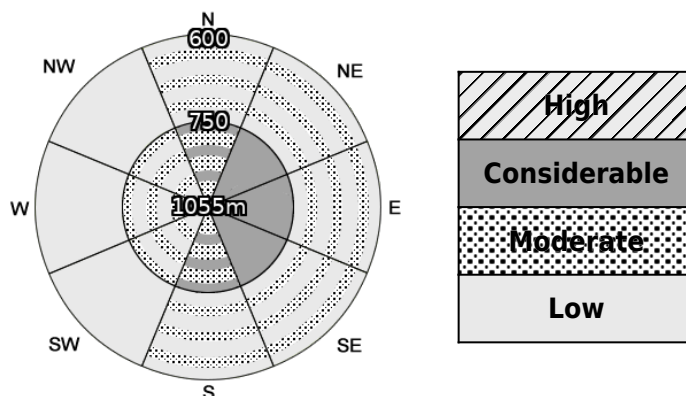

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Unstable windslab will accumulate overnight and morning, primarily on North-East to Southerly aspects above 700m. Elsewhere stability will generally be good. Cornices will also start to develop on these aspects. Elsewhere stability will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, strengthening winds veering from South-West through North-West then North will bring snowfall sometimes heavy to low levels mainly overnight and early morning. Freezing level 400 metres.

**Comments**

A lovely calm day in Torridon with good views. Crampons were useful from snow level upwards.
