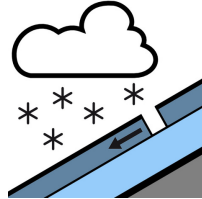

Wind Slab



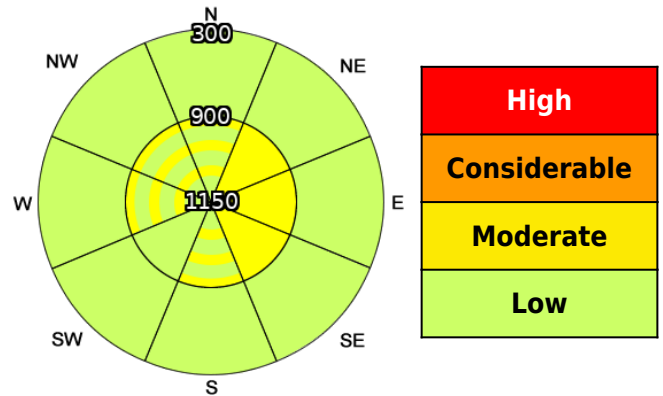

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will slowly soften as the freezing level rises but will remain generally well bonded. On North-East to South-Easterly aspects localised deposits of moderately bonded windslab will exist above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry, the winds will become strong from a South-Westerly direction. Overnight, freezing at most levels then rising during the day to around the summits.

Comments

A South-Westerly airstream will affect the area for the next couple of days this will change temperatures and increase wind speeds.
