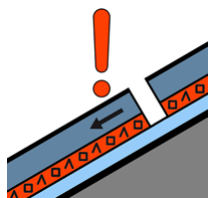

Avalanche Problems



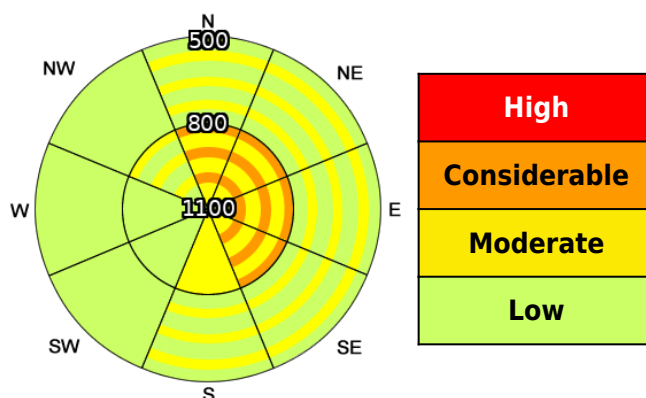
Persistent Weak Layers



New Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instability expected to persist but become more localised on very steep North through East to South East aspects above 800m. All windward slopes and exposed ridges expected to show good stability. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry with winds increasing to strong West South Westerly, later South Westerly. Remaining cold overnight but with a rise in freezing level to just below summits late morning.

Comments

Very good general cover above 700m with deeper drifts above 800m and expanses of hard scoured snow-ice. Complex freezing level change forecast during the morning with summits temps expected to rise to no higher than 0 degrees C.
