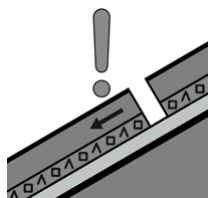


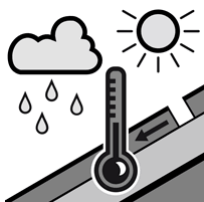

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 31/12/2014

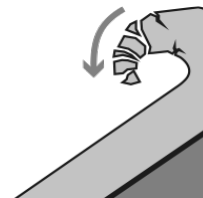

Persistent Weak Layers



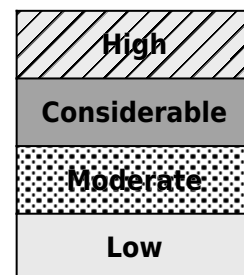
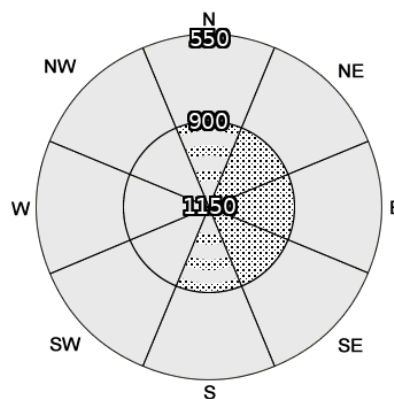

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow will continue to thaw at all levels. Localised areas of moderately bonded snow will be present in steeper, sheltered locations on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Greatest hazard will come from the risk of collapsing cornices. Rock and ice fall could also present a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain throughout the day. Mild with the freezing level above the summits. Strong South-South-Westerly winds.

Comments

Mild for 48 hours, getting colder by Friday.
