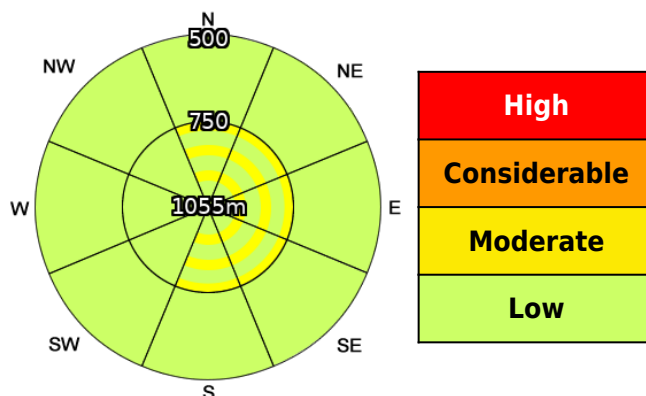

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The diminishing snowpack will remain moist, but remains generally stable throughout. Some wet snow instabilities may be present in the steepest but isolated locations in gullies and steep coire back walls, mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse and falling ice will continue to be a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Mild temperatures will continue during the day, freezing levels well above the summits, Heavy rain is expected. Winds very strong South-West, to North-Westerly at the end of the day. Colder at end of day with some sleet and snow expected on the summits.

#### Comments
