

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 01/01/2015



Persistent Weak Layers





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels. Instabilities will persist on steep slopes and gullies, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Cornices will be prone to spontaneous collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits. After overnight rain showers persistent rain at all levels will continue throughout the day. Winds will be very strong mainly South-South-Westerly.

##### Comments

Rock and ice fall is an additional hazard in these thaw conditions. Have a great New Year.
