

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snow will freeze overnight and fresh deposits of windslab will progressively build on North East through to South East aspects, mainly above 700m. Instabilities will exist in significant accumulations of windslab in gully exits and steep coire back walls. Cornices will develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force, cold westerly winds will develop overnight and continue through tomorrow with frequent snow showers. Freezing level will drop to around 200 metres overnight.
