

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initial improvement in general stability as the old wet snowpack re-freezes. Localised, marginally stabilised windslab will build mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 750m. Some new cornice development expected. Best stability on windward slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain turning to snow overnight as it becomes much colder. Strong generally Westerly winds.

Comments

All rivers and watercourses running full or flooding on New Years Day. 550m cloudbase for most of the day. Much more wintry conditions in prospect.
