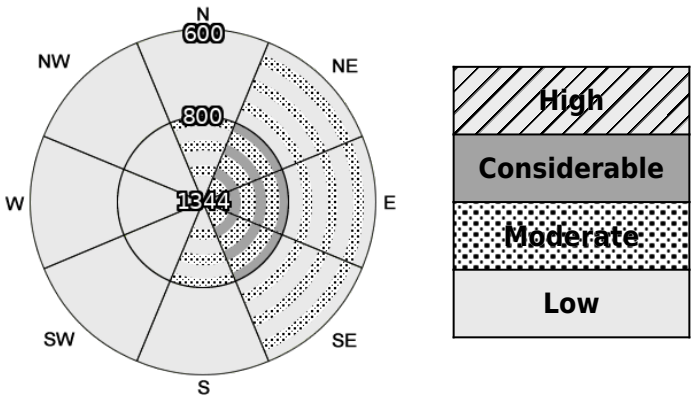

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered locations on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres, generally deposits are not expected to be extensive, but the tops of gullies and coire rims will be most affected. Windward slopes will be scoured and will hold very little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow showers will die out through the day. Strong Westerly winds will ease. The freezing level will drop from about 600 metres to 400 metres through the period.
