

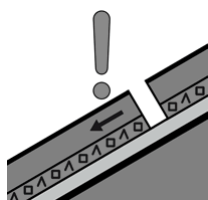

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 03/01/2015

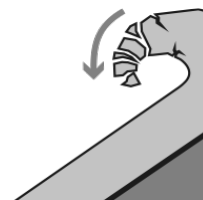

Wind Slab



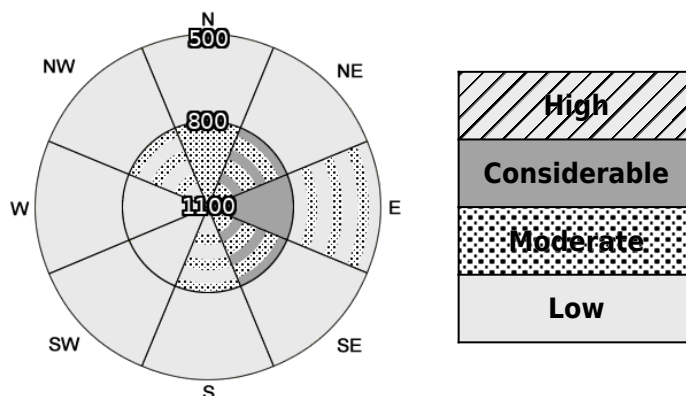
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability on all windward slopes. Weakly stabilised windslab will persist on very sheltered scarp slopes, gully tops and hollows on East aspects above 800m. Localised accumulations of weak windslab will also lie on selected North-East to South-East facing aspects above the same altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow showers dying out by dawn. Strong, generally Westerly winds moderating during daylight hours. Remaining cold.

Comments

Plenty of wind transport today as well as a lot of scouring. Snowfall consisted mainly of hail and graupel.
