

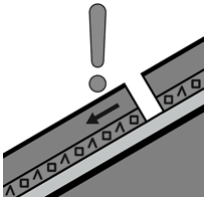

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 04/01/2015

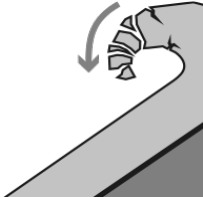
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



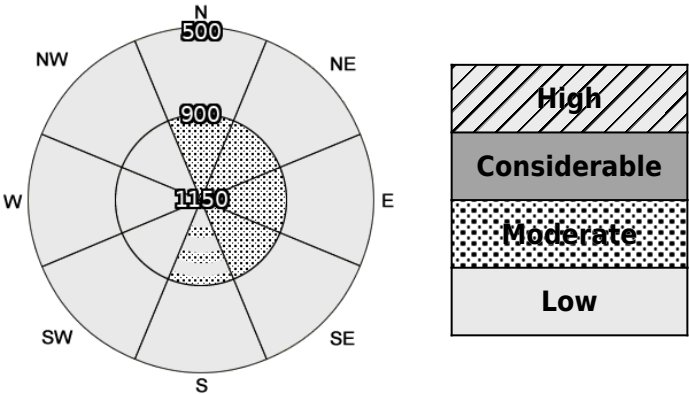
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will remain firm and icy in many locations giving good stability. Areas of moderately bonded windslab will remain in wind sheltered locations, mainly above 900 meters in summit gully exits and on steep slopes with a North through East to South-Easterly aspect. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mainly dry with fresh to strong Westerly winds. Cold overnight with freezing level rising through the course of the day.

Comments

Great weather for the hill with a fair amount of sunshine. Melt-freeze conditions have formed a slick surface on rocks and older snow.
