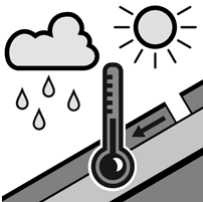


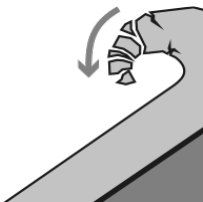

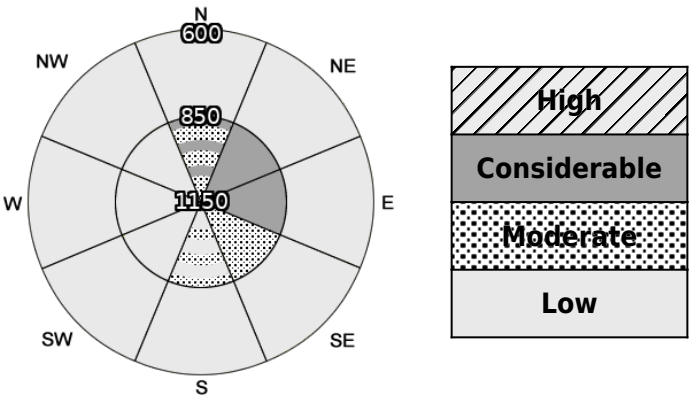

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will generally remain stable but with some surface softening. Rising temperatures will form wet snow instabilities in areas where recent windslab exists mainly in sheltered summit gullies and on steeper slopes with North through East to South-Easterly aspect above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Milder conditions with light rain at all levels will affect the area overnight and through the course of the day. Winds will be strong from a South-South-Westerly direction.

Comments

Milder outlook, hazard of cornice collapse and rock fall.
