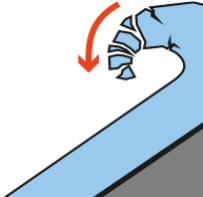

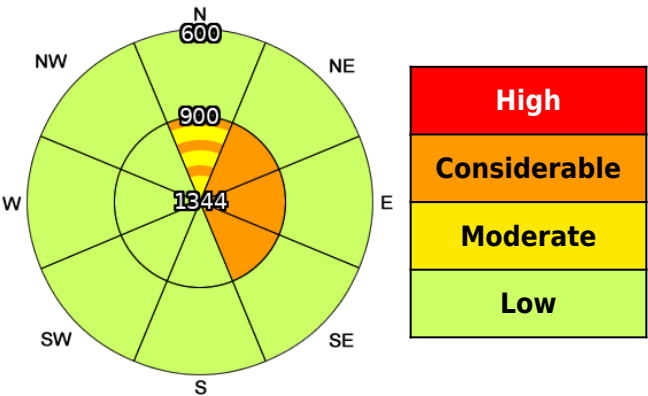

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing wet snowpack will refreeze and become stable. Fresh areas of unstable windslab will form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Some Northerly aspects will be affected by cross loading. Unstable cornices will form above these aspects. Avalanches are likely in these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snow showers are expected early in the morning as the freezing level drops to around 900m. Winds will ease and become moderate Westerly .
