

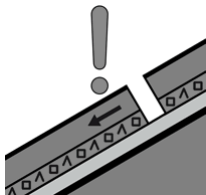

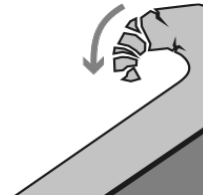

Wind Slab



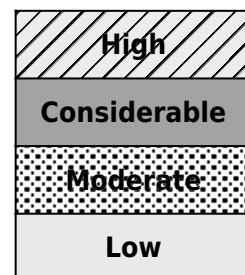
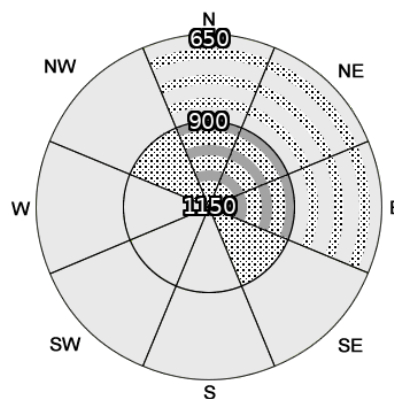

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Old snow will refreeze and generally be stable. Pockets of unstable windslab will develop in very sheltered features mostly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Some North-West and South-East aspects will also be affected due to cross-loading. Cornices will start to redevelop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming cooler with snow showers throughout the period. Strong to gale force winds will be from the South-West to West.
