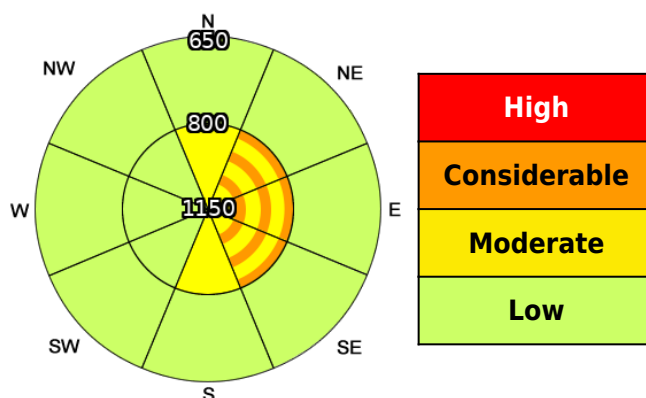


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 10/01/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be a period of instability overnight with existing snow starting to refreeze and stabilise by dawn. Isolated areas of new unstable windslab will develop on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. This will not be widespread and generally be restricted to very sheltered locations. North and South aspects will also be affected by cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Thaw conditions overnight followed by a return to cooler conditions with light snow down to around 500 metres. Storm force winds will be from the West.
