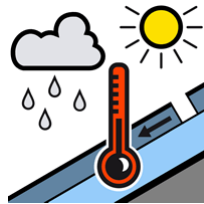

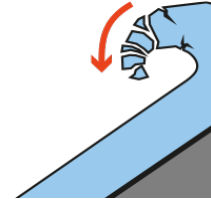

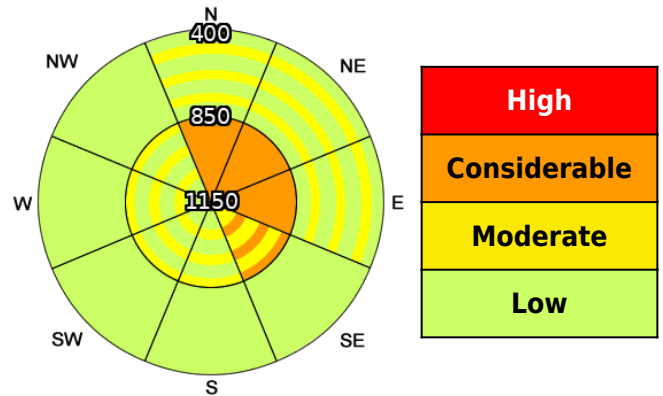

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of considerable instability during Sunday evening as the freezing level rises and rain effects the snowpack. During Monday, fresh areas of unstable windslab will develop in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 850m. Cross loading will also affect other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Tonight the freezing level will rise to around the summits with snow showers above 950 metres. During the early morning the freezing is due to fall again to 400 metres with frequent snow showers. The winds will be strong from the South-Westerly direction.

Comments

Another melt freeze cycle followed by more snow showers.
