

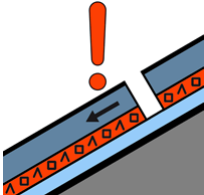

Avalanche Problems



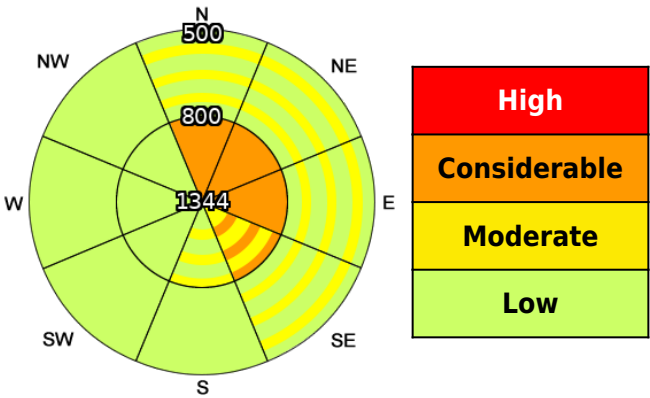
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable accumulations will continue to be deposited on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Some sheltered areas on other aspects will be affected by cross loading. Windward facing slopes will be scoured and hold little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with the freezing level of around 200 metres. Strong winds will be from the South-West. There will be snow showers through the period.

Comments

Cold, windy and showery conditions expected to continue for a few days yet.
