

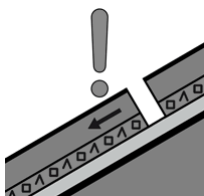

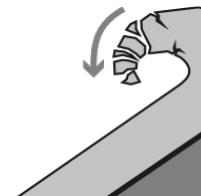

Wind Slab



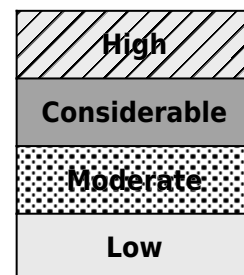
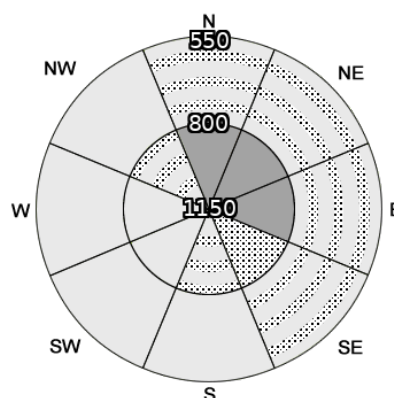

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further accumulations of deep unstable windslab will continue to develop in steep, sheltered locations mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres and avalanches are likely. Other aspects will also be affected by cross-loading. Unstable cornices will continue to develop. Deep drifts will also develop at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers with the freezing level lifting slightly to around 500 metres. Gale force winds will back from the South-West to the South by the end of the day.
