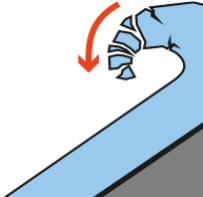

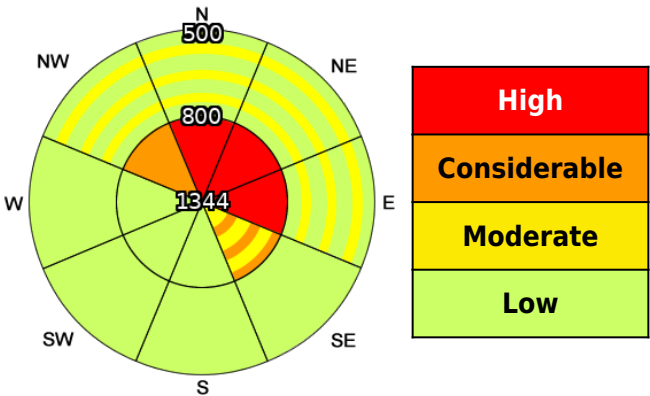

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable snow will be present on many aspects. Greatest accumulations will be on North North-East and East aspects above 800m with redistribution occurring onto North-West aspects. Avalanches will occur notably on North and North-Easterly aspects. Localised instabilities will be present in other locations. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing snow showers. The freezing level will rise briefly overnight and lower early Thursday. Winds will be strong from a Southerly direction.
