

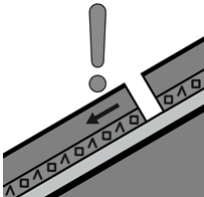

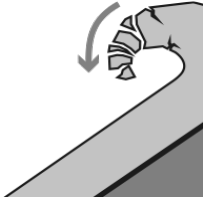

Wind Slab



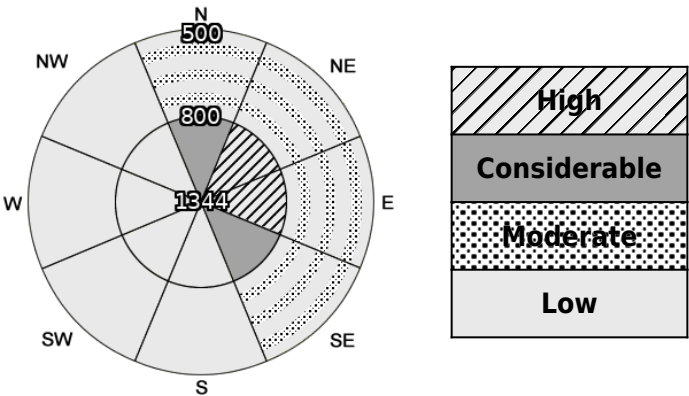
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable snow will continue to form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. Cross loading will also affect other aspects. Avalanches will occur in these locations. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue accompanied by strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will gradually fall to around 200m.
