

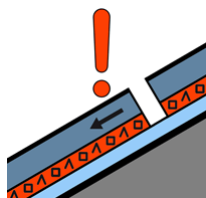

Wind Slab



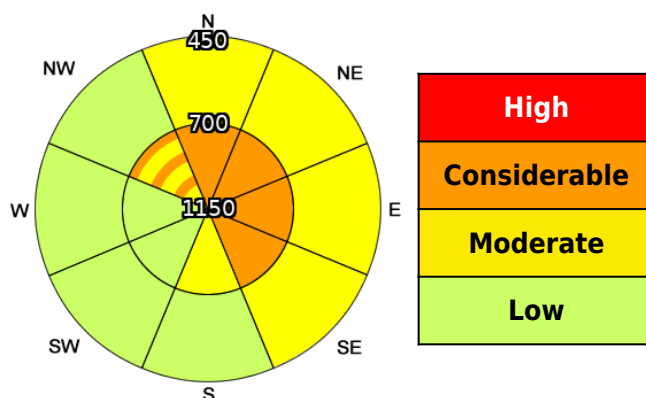
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor to weakly bonded windslab will be found on mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres. Avalanches are likely in sheltered locations due to persistent drifting of deposits. Fragile cornices will be present. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will become much colder with some light snowfall to valley level. The very strong West-North-Westerly winds will back West-South-Westerly during the day.
