

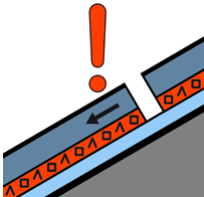

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 17/01/2015

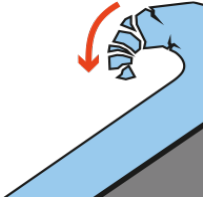
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant areas of windslab will exist on North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres where avalanches are likely. Some sheltered locations on other aspects will be affected by cross-loading. Unstable cornices will exist. Exposed windward aspects will generally be scoured and will hold little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will ease and become isolated by the afternoon. Westerly winds will back to the South and also ease. It will remain cold.
