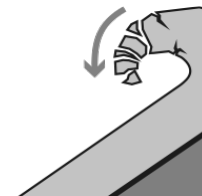

Wind Slab



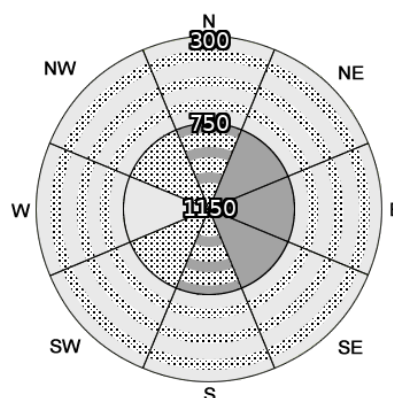

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant areas of poor and moderately bonded windslab will remain on North-East to South-East aspects above 750 metres. Sheltered locations on other aspects, particularly North and South, will also be affected by the redistribution of windslab. Some weak cornices will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with a few snow showers through the period. Moderate winds will vary in direction from between the South-West, through West to North.
