

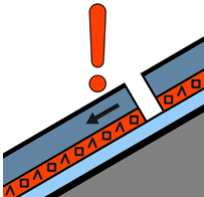

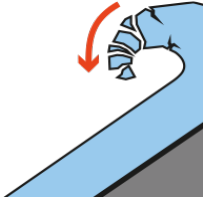

Wind Slab



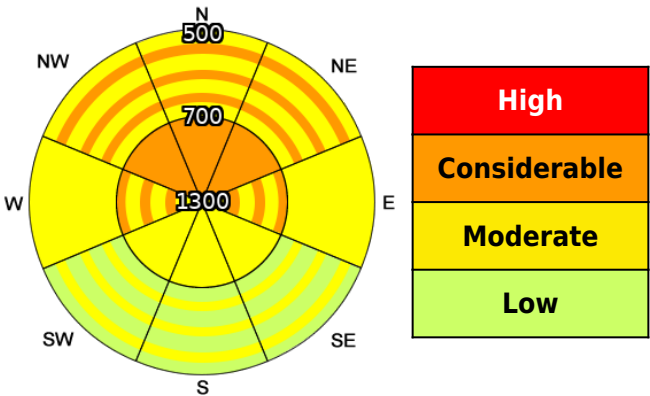
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of deep unstable windslab will be present on mainly North-West to North-Easterly aspects above 700 metres, where avalanches are likely. Localised accumulations of unstable windslab is present below this level but mainly above 500 metres with wind sheltered locations, steep slopes and gullies most affected. Other aspects will be affected due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be strong South-South-Easterly, lessening slightly at the end of the day. No precipitation is expected. Freezing level will be around 500 metres.
