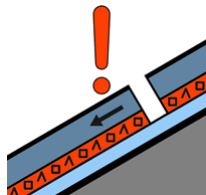
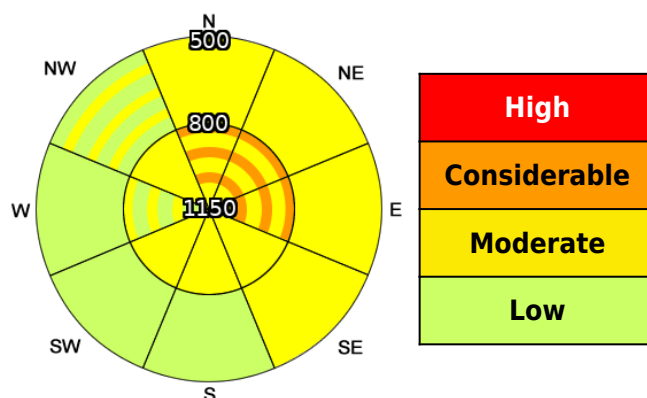


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 21/01/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Persistent Weak Layers****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The colder temperatures will help maintain the localised poor to weakly bonded windslab which is mainly to be found on steep sheltered North to East aspects with instabilities also persisting on steeper slopes on most other aspects above 800 metres. Newly formed cornices will require care. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a trace of fresh snow overnight it will remain dry. Fresh winds from the South will ease throughout the day. The freezing level will remain around 300 metres.

Comments

Generally snow cover is good with most aspects holding snow. Ridges remain scoured.
