

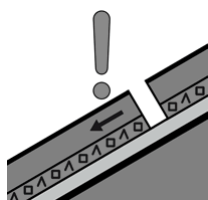

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 21/01/2015

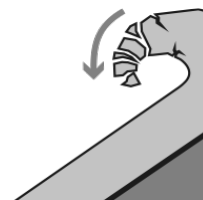

Wind Slab



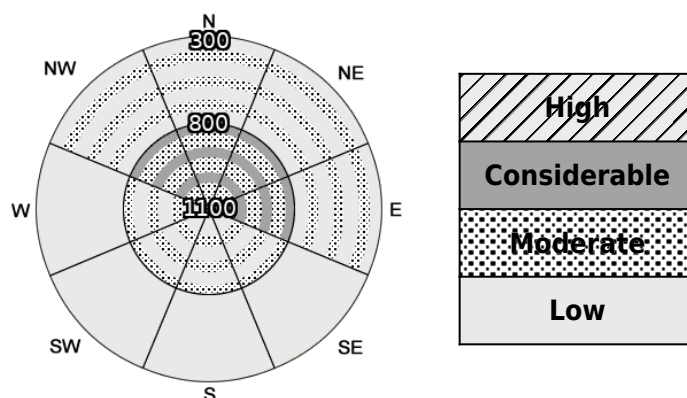

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some redistribution of existing snow overnight with fresh windslab forming on North-West to North-East aspects above 800m. The cold temperatures will maintain localised instabilities on mostly steep Easterly facing slopes, although other, very sheltered aspects above the same altitude will also be affected. Recently formed cornices remain suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold, the overnight fresh to moderate South Easterly winds will ease slightly during the day. A mostly dry, overcast day again is expected with possible light snow flurries early afternoon.
