



## Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. Areas of moderately bonded windslab will remain on North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres. Some patches of windslab will also exist in sheltered locations on other aspects. There may be some redistribution onto Northerly aspects towards the end of the period, however these deposits are likely to be small and shallow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.





## **Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry with a freezing level of 400 metres or less. Light and variable winds will strengthen from the South towards the end of the period.

#### **Comments**

Another fine winter's day expected on Thursday, before a return to more unsettled conditions on Friday.
