

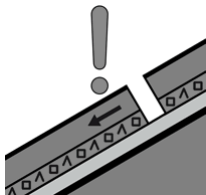

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 23/01/2015

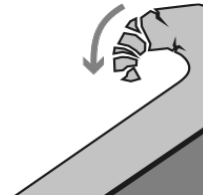
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



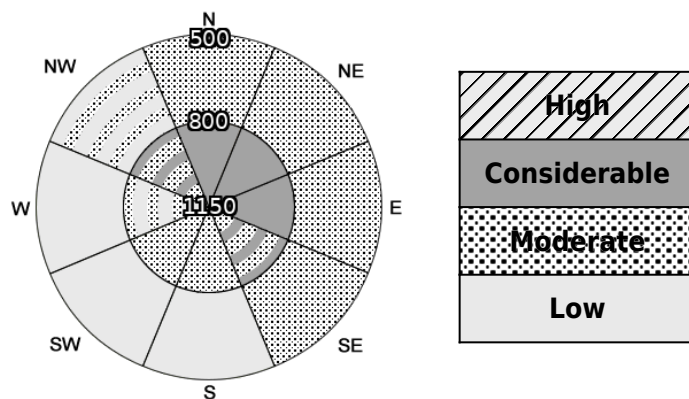
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will develop during the day, mostly in sheltered locations on North to Easterly aspects above 800 metres. North-West and South-East aspects will also be affected by cross-loaded deposits. Unstable cornices will continue to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will slowly rise to around 700 metres with snow showers becoming heavier during the day. Strong winds from the South veering West later in the day.

Comments

Some fluctuations with freezing levels expected over the next couple of days. Worth checking recent weather and avalanche forecasts.
