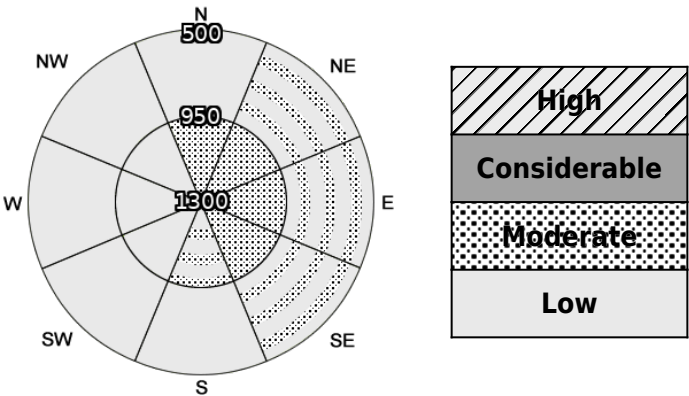
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will eventually become more stable as the freezing level falls. New accumulations of windslab will develop on North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. Corrie rims and gully tops will be most affected. Localised windslab will form on other aspects due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Much cooler with snow showers on strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will gradually fall overnight to 600 metres.

Comments

Very mild, midday temperatures plus 10 degrees C at 600m!
