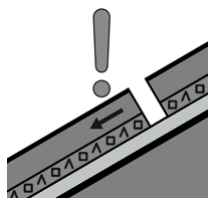

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 26/01/2015

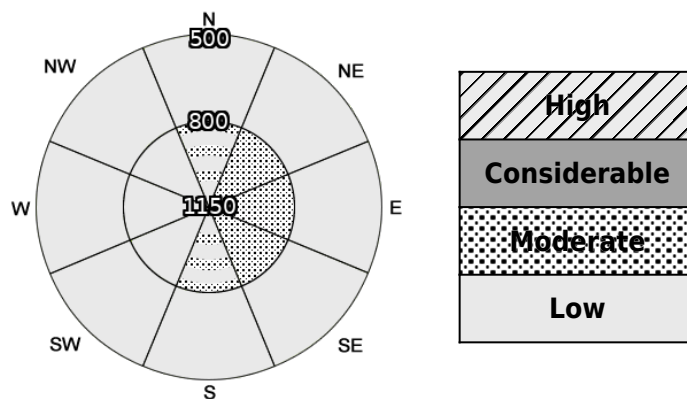
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will refreeze and stabilise, however instabilities will persist on steep terrain mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Gully exits and corrie rims will be most affected. Exposed ridges will remain scoured and mostly clear of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming cooler with the freezing level dropping to around 600 metres and some very light snowfall later in the afternoon. Winds gusting severe gale force mainly from the West.
