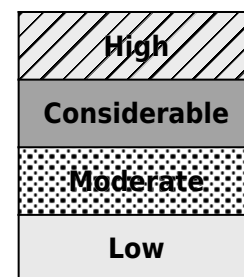
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A re-freeze will see improved stability in all locations. Some new snow instabilities are possible on some very steep, sheltered lee North East to South East aspects above 800m, although these new accumulations are not expected to be significant. Good stability on all scoured and exposed ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler overnight with the Freezing levels lowering to below 400m. A cold front will bring a few light snow showers to the area, these will mostly die away as the day progresses. Winds will be moderate to strong West South West, West, becoming West North West.

Comments

Some improvement in ice formation on horizon with return of cooler conditions.
