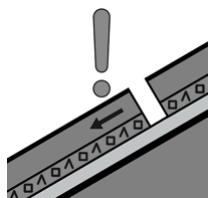

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 27/01/2015

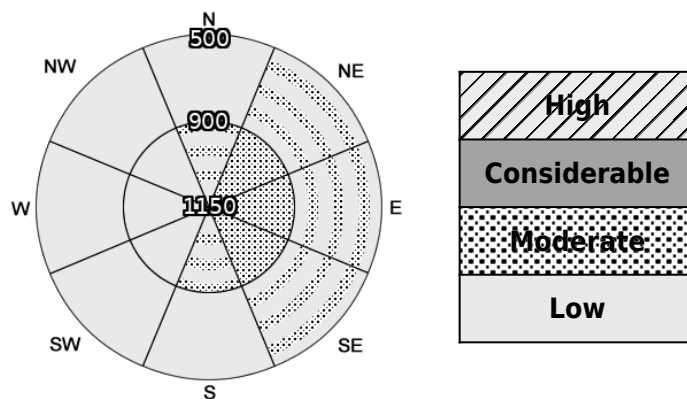
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will soften but in most locations it will remain generally well bonded at all levels. However instabilities will be found on steep terrain, such as gully exits and steep burn lines, mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Exposed ridges will remain scoured icy and mostly stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to above the summits. It will be mainly dry but there will be very light rain towards the end of the day. Winds will be gusting gale force by afternoon.

Comments

Well frozen snow and ice on the hills today but freezing levels lifting over the summits during Tuesday.
