

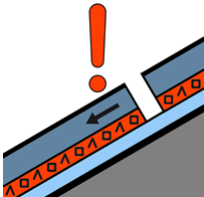

Avalanche Problems



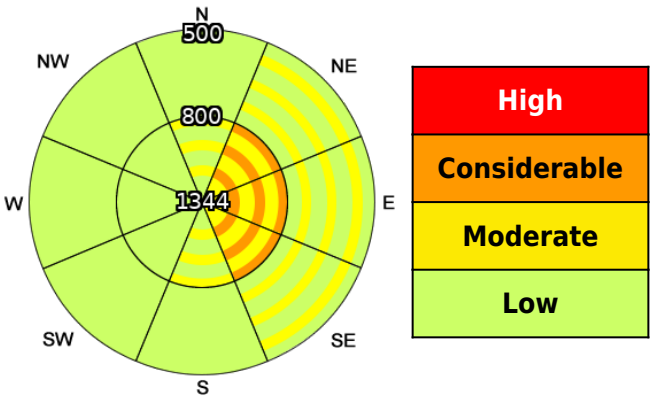
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will freeze and stabilise at all levels. Fresh areas of unstable windslab will form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. Due to the strong winds, significant accumulations will be localised in distribution. Cross loading will also affect other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will lower to 200m overnight. Rain will turn to snow with moderate accumulations. Winds will be strong from the West
