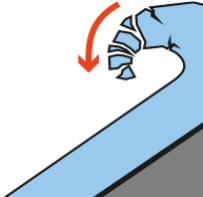

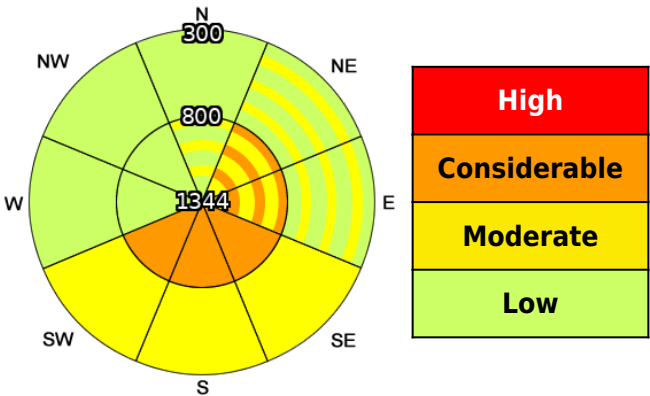

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Northerly winds will start to redistribute the existing soft snow. Unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on steep South-East, South and South-West aspects. Existing windslab will persist on sheltered East and North-East aspects. Wind blown slopes will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Northerly winds and snow showers. The freezing level will be around 200m.
