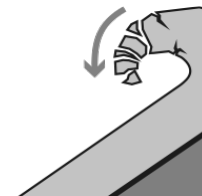

Wind Slab



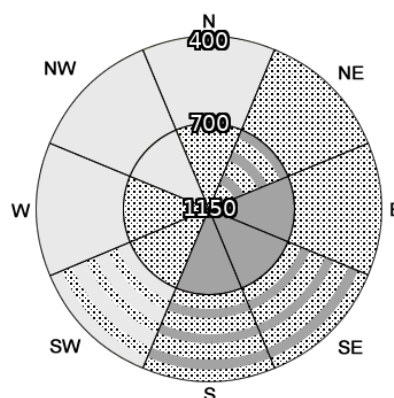

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deep poor to weakly bonded windslab will be found in sheltered locations, mostly on East to Southerly aspects above 700 metres where avalanches are likely. Instabilities will also affect steep and convex slopes on other aspects and at lower altitudes. Where terrain is exposed to the wind it will be scoured and icy. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will become slightly cooler with the freezing level dropping to valley level. Snow showers, heavy overnight, easing during the day. Winds will also ease slightly, becoming strong from the North-North-West.

Comments

A very poor day for observations! Snowfall and winds will ease during Sunday.
