

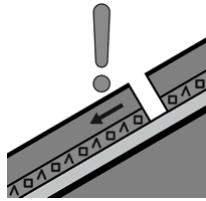

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 01/02/2015

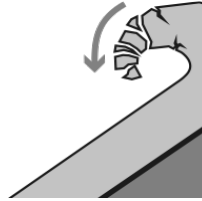
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



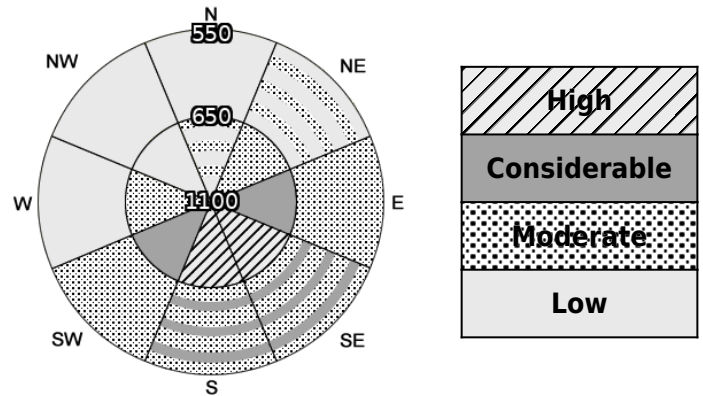
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Very poor stability on all recent lee slopes where avalanches will occur. Most affected locations will be steep South East to South aspects above 650m with cross-loading expected on some East and South West facing slopes and gullies. All new cornices will be weak and prone to spontaneous collapse. Exposed ridges will offer best safe travel options. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Northerly winds and snow showers continuing overnight. Wind and precipitation easing during Sunday. Remaining very cold.

Comments

Very wintry on Saturday with limited access due to deep snow, blizzard conditions and very difficult road conditions. Backcountry mountain sport compromised by not being able to get to the backcountry.
