

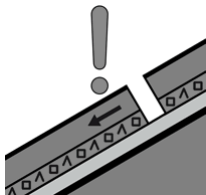

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 03/02/2015

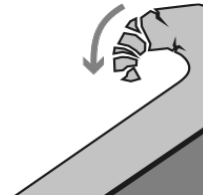
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



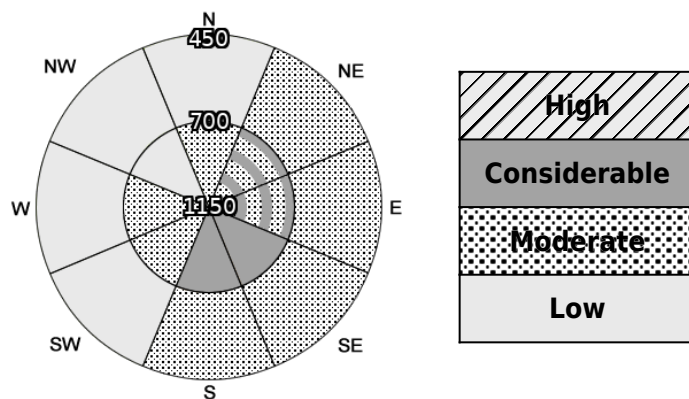
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will be found on steep, sheltered locations above 700 metres. Most affected are South-East and Southerly aspects with isolated areas also on East aspects above 700 metres. Many areas are scoured and will remain icy and stable. Newly formed cornices require care. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to around 500 metres with only a little snowfall later in the afternoon. Winds will strengthen, particularly in the afternoon, and veer to the North.

Comments

Many areas have been scoured and are stable giving good walking options. Other aspects offer good ski touring, firm in places.
