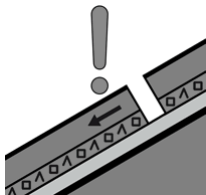
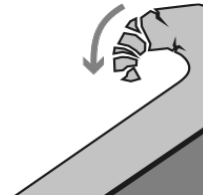
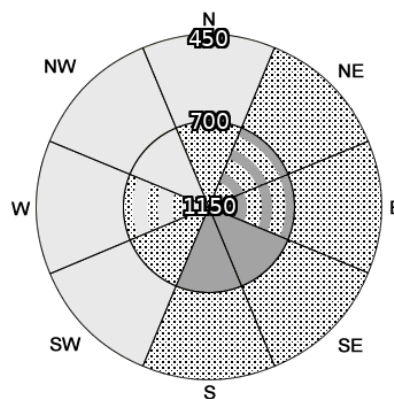

There will be some redistribution of deposits, mainly overnight, more limited during the day. Consolidation will continue to take place but deeper deposits in sheltered locations on mainly South-East and South aspects above 700 metres will remain poorly bonded. Localised instabilities will be present in very sheltered locations on some North-East, East and South-West aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight fresh North-North-Westerly winds will ease to moderate during the day. It will be dry with the freezing level rising slowly.

Highly varied conditions underfoot - possible to quickly move from scoured terrain to deep drifts.
