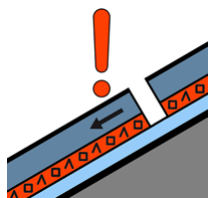


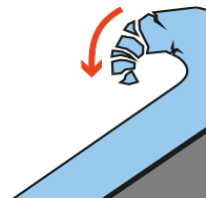

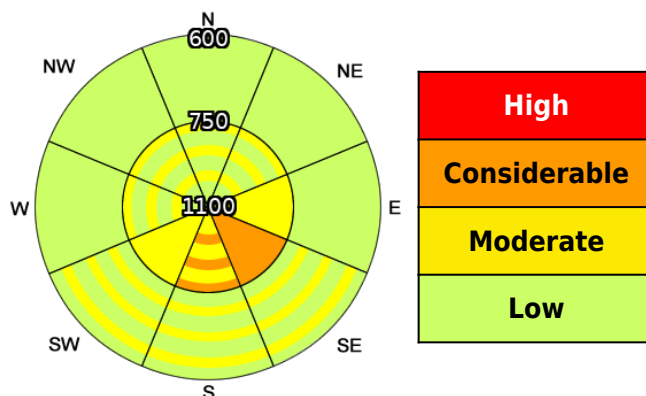
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fluctuating temperatures will bring additional consolidation on all aspects and altitudes except South-East to South. In addition, glide cracks will continue to widen on some selected very steep South East aspects at around 750m. Cornices will continue to collapse as the freezing level rises overnight. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Very light and variable winds throughout. Freezing level around plateau level overnight then becoming a little cooler as it falls to around 650m during the day. Temperature inversion conditions may mean summits temporarily above zero.

Comments

Great snow cover but with varied snow surface ranging from firm sastrugi near plateau level to corn snow in places at lower altitudes. Very thin crust in some locations, too.
