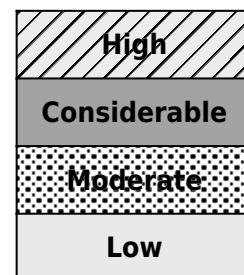
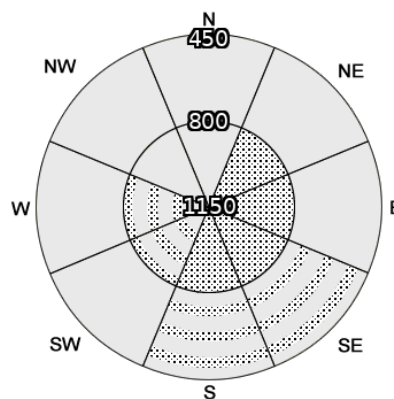
Persistent Weak Layers



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Surface layers will start to firm up overnight due to cooler temperatures. Moderately bonded snow will be present in steeper, sheltered locations on mainly North-East through East to South aspects above 800 metres. There may be potential for cornice collapse at lower elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a mainly clear night, cloud will build during the day. The winds will increase to become fresh to strong, generally Northerly. The air temperature will reach approximately 1 degree centigrade at 900 metres in the middle of the day.

Potential for significant wind chill at higher elevations.
