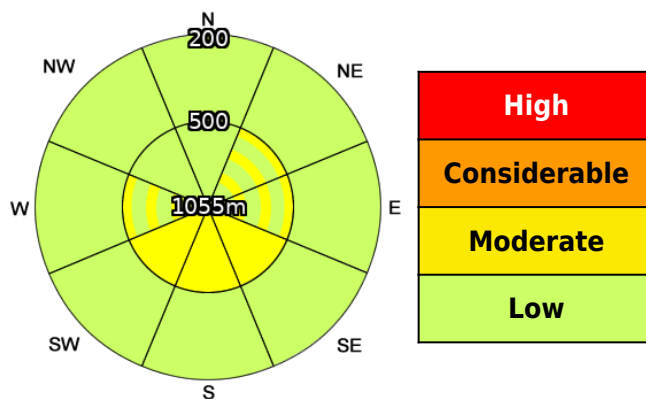
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate above 500m with the snowpack remaining wet below this level. On slopes of a Southerly aspect where there is any radiation, there will be the risk of single point wet snow avalanches. There will also be potential for falling ice from buttresses and cornice collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing thaw with slightly strengthening westerly winds accompanied by light scattered snow showers above 600 metres.

Comments

Below 500m travel is difficult due to wet unconsolidated snow. Above this level, travel is easier, especially if you find old footsteps.
