

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to consolidate above 500m and will remain wet below this level. On slopes of East to Southerly aspects, where there is any radiation, there will be the risk of of single point wet snow avalanches. There will also be potential for falling ice from buttresses and cornice collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Continuing thaw with strengthening Westerly winds accompanied by light scattered snow showers above 650m

**Comments**

A lot of snow has disappeared from below 200m. Above this travel is difficult due to wet unconsolidated snow. However this improves as height is gained. If you are able to use previous footsteps this makes life a lot easier.
