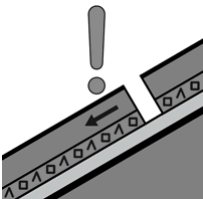


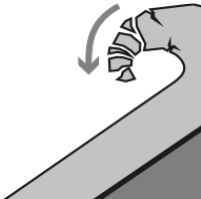

Avalanche Problems



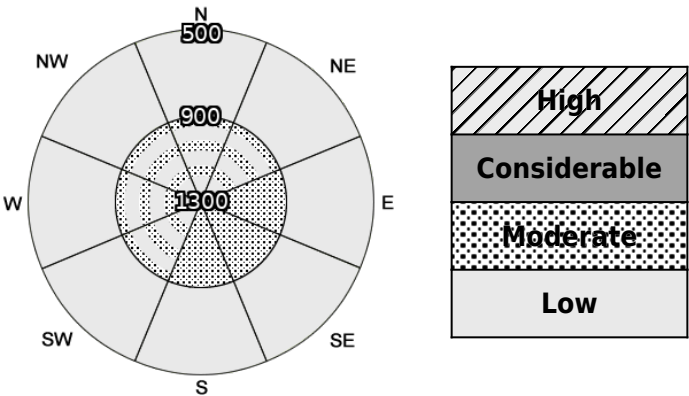
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The overall snowpack will continue to consolidate. Instabilities beneath the crust will remain in steep and convex terrain on Easterly to Southerly aspects above 900 metres. Stability will be generally good elsewhere with localised moderately bonded soft windslab affecting some steep shaded slopes. Cornices will be prone to sudden collapse potentially triggering slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions will continue. Winds will be moderate to strong West-South-Westerly. An inversion will lead to bands of mild and cooler air with temperatures below freezing at different altitudes.
