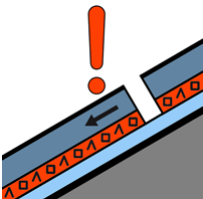


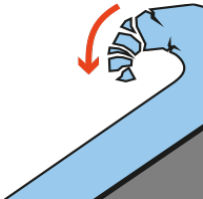

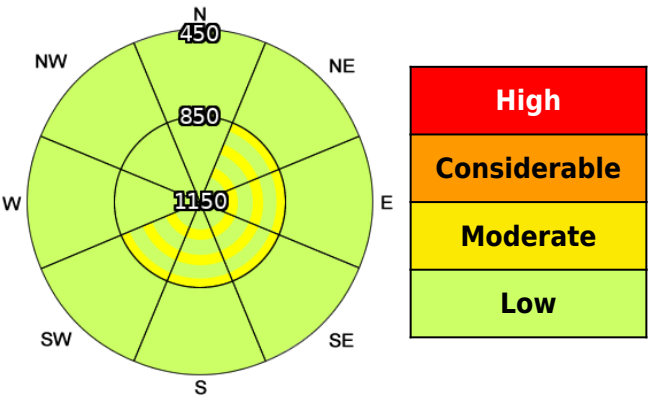
Persistent Weak Layers



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate, mostly being firm and generally well bonded. Areas of softer moderately bonded snow will be found on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 850 metres, particularly in steep, sheltered locations at higher elevations. Cornices require care. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and mostly sunny. The freezing level will fluctuate around the summits. The winds will be fresh, initially from the North-West but will back throughout the day to the South.

Comments

Fluctuating freezing levels, though will probably lift above the summits in the afternoon. Firm snow-ice with long run out's in some locations.
