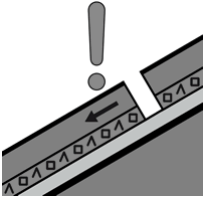


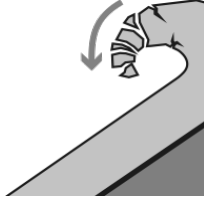

Avalanche Problems



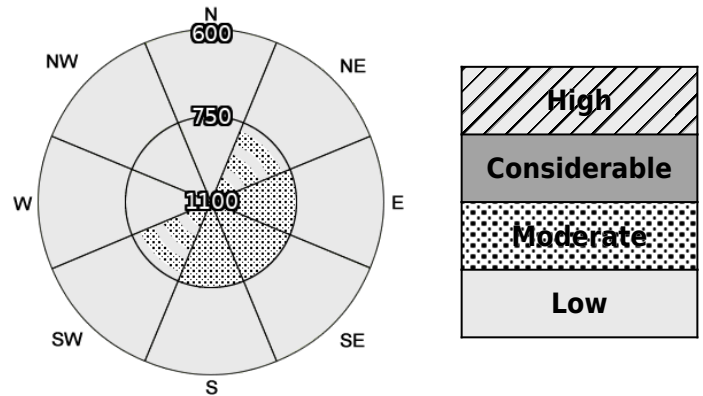
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. The snowpack will continue to consolidate in most locations though residual instability will persist in older windslab deposits on very steep East to South aspects above 750m. Full depth glide cracks will continue to widen on selected East to South-East aspects above 750m. Cornices will be prone to slumping and collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Complex temperature inversion conditions will prevail giving generally cool temperatures though summits may be temporarily above freezing. Winds will be moderate to strong South-Westerly.

Comments

General snow cover remains very good though some snow loss noted at very lowest elevations.
