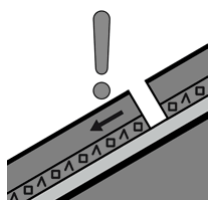

Avalanche Problems



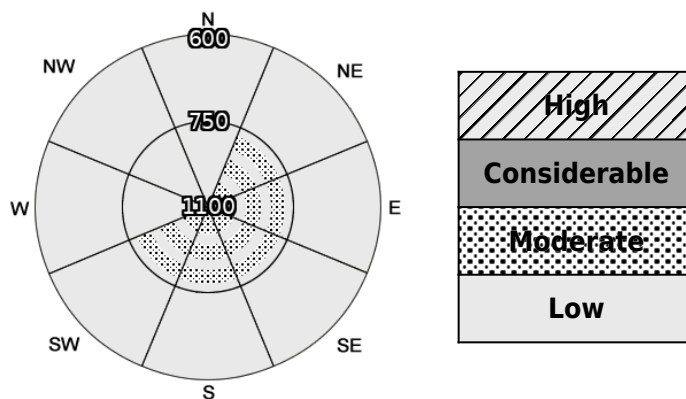
Persistent Weak Layers



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow pack will continue to consolidate and be generally stable. Some isolated instabilities will remain on steep and convex terrain on North - East to South - West aspects above 750metres. Overhanging cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The general dry conditions will remain with some cloud. Freezing level will be around the summit.

Comments

Areas of snow from the road side upwards were firm with an icy surface crust. This surface crust softened later in the day. Wind exposed areas are blown clear of snow.
