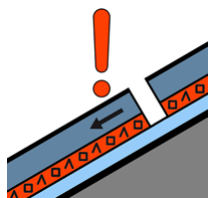


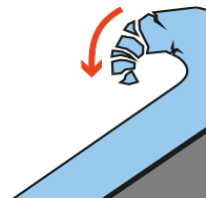

Avalanche Problems



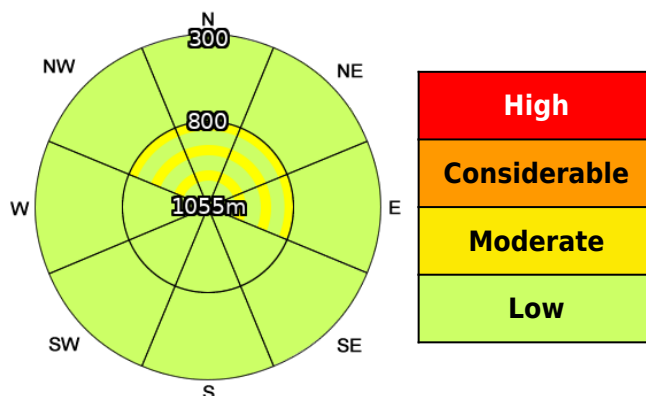
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow will remain generally stable. Isolated and generally avoidable pockets of instability will be present on steep shaded North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. The risk of collapsing ice continues. Many areas are free from snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with light to moderate East winds throughout the forecast period. Overnight the freezing level will be around the summits rising later in the day.

Comments

Less snow cover above Torridon village, more cover on Easterly aspects of Beinn Eighe. Ice far thinner in Coireag Dubh Mor than recently.
