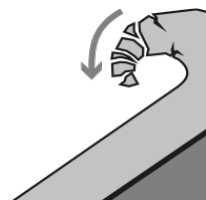
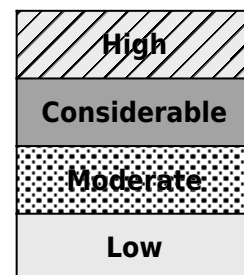
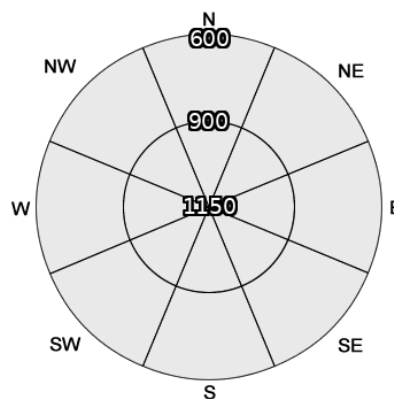

The snowpack will refreeze, remaining firm and well bonded at all levels and in all locations. Higher plateau areas will be icy with some areas snow free. Cornices will continue to be a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will be around 800 metres for most of the day but may rise briefly to summit level. There will be some very light snow with strong winds from the South.
