





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New weak windslab will accumulate quickly on all steep North West through North to East aspects above 700m where avalanches are likley. New weak cornice development expected above steep lee slopes. Lingering hazard of full depth avalanches on selected steep East to South aspects at around 750m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent snow showers overnight extending throughout the day. Strong Southerly winds easing during the day and becoming South westerly later Westerly. Much colder temperatures.

Comments

Much more wintry weather in prospect. Full depth avalanche potential will remain on steep E to S aspects in addition to new snow hazard.
